b. Chalk Talk (15-20 minutes)

We established a common understanding/language before we began action planning by answering the question, "What is Academic Assessment?" We silently wrote our thoughts down and commented/elaborated on others' thoughts. Once everyone stopped writing, we read all the comments and discussed what we think academic assessment is.

c. Affinity Map (40-50 minutes)

We took some time to read the Alignment Matrix handout. This is a crosswalk of the 4 major goals from the HLC assessment report, the action steps/recommendations from the annual SAA report, and the affinity protocol responses from faculty and staff from the question "How can we increase student learning?" at the convocation in January.

In response to the questions, "What actions do we need to take next?", we each wrote one thought per sticky note and stuck them to the blank chart paper. Silently we each read through all the sticky notes and moved them around, grouping them into affinities. We read them aloud together and refined the affinities and named each.

d. Action Plan (2.5-3 hours)

Using the categories/affinities and the sticky notes within each, we developed the activities/steps SCC needs to take to improve academic assessment and student learning outcomes.
