Dr. Muckler is working on the Competency-Based Education application for the Welding program. He presented a document and asked for guidance since the HLC site states:

“Before applying for HLC approval of a CBE program, institutions should understand the Council of Regional Accrediting Commissions’ (C-RAC’s) Common Framework for Defining and Approving Competency-Based Education Programs...”

SAAT reviewed the 11 evaluation considerations and agreed that most, if not all, relate directly to assessment. A post-graduation survey would help answer the final question.
